- We encourage drivers to pre registration.
- Registration forms are due back August 22, 2009
- This is so we get a idea of which drivers are interested in the events
- If you don't pre register you still are able to drive in the events
- We don't want to refuse anybody
- All driver's and pit people must pay for pit passes

Skid Plate Race, Gauntlet, Car Soccer Rules

These vehicles are being built so that they can perform in one or all three events listed above. Pre registration is highly recommended.

Skid Plate Racing objective: with the front wheel drive cars there will be skid plates in place of the rear wheels and will be racing around the track like that. Skid plate can not go beyond back bumper. (See attached pictures for example of Skid Plate and length of skid plate.)

Gauntlet Objective: A number of vehicles will be chasing and trying to disable a bigger vehicle around the track. The bigger vehicle to be determined, later bus, limo, Hurst, and etc.

Car Soccer Objective: Two teams of cars will be playing soccer with the vehicles a big ball will have to be pushed, hit, smashed into the goal. The team with the most goals wins.

- 1) Driver's safety #1
- 2) Any vehicle that is 80 and newer that has front wheel drive can perform in the Skid Plate race. Compact to Mid size rear wheel drive cars can perform in the Car Soccer, Gauntlet.
- 3) All burnable interior must be removed; removal of dash is optional all insulation under hood must be removed.
- 4) No antifreeze in vehicles.
- 5) Vehicles may be reinforced in front end driver's door must be reinforced with one or two bars. Bars must go at least 6 inch past each door seam.
- 6) Driver's door must have window net or screen roll cage or roll protection is allowed.
- 7) Helmets, long sleeve shirts and pants are required
- 8) Shoulder and lap belts are required racing harness is recommended
- 9) Must have a one or two digit number to identify the vehicle
- 10) Air bags must be removed
- 11) All glass must be removed except windshields
- 12) Must have working brakes. Vehicles must be able to stop.

Trailer Race Rules

- 1) Any full size tow vehicle will be approved, cars, suv, pick ups, vans, etc... Four wheel drive vehicles are allowed, NO CONVERTIBLES.
- 2) Tow vehicles must be stripped of all side glass. Windshield may be left in but must be protected with window screen. It is highly recommended that all interiors be stripped off flammable materials (carpets, headliners, door panels, bottom of rear seat, etc) All exterior lights and body molding must be removed. Heavy wire mesh must be installed over entire windshield if the glass has been removed. A wire mesh or a racing type window net must be installed over the driver's window opening.
- 3) No lift kits or suspension alterations allowed.
- 4) Reinforcing of the vehicle is recommended. (Brush guards or make it look like mad max!)
- 5) Driver's doors must be welded shut or chained shut.
- 6) Roll cages or roll protection is highly recommended.
- 7) Tow vehicles must display a one or two digit number to identify the vehicle.
- 8) If your vehicle has an air bag (s) it must be disconnected and must be removed.
- 9) Helmets are mandatory! Fire suits are recommended. Long sleeve shirts and pants are required.
- 10) Trailer hitches can be attached to the tow vehicle by directly welding or bolting to the frame or bumper. Standard ball may be welded to secure in place.
- 11) Safety chains are allowed. If your trailer comes detached from the tow vehicle you will be DQ'd.
- 12) Shoulder and lap belt are required. Racing harness is recommended.
- 13) Vehicle must be free of antifreeze.
- 14) Must have working brakes.
- 15) Best Decorated trailer will be given an award

Trailer to be used

- Campers, pop-ups and fiberglass boats any other types of trailers must be approved by the judges
- NO FARM MACHINERY TRAILERS OR PICK-UP BOX TRAILERS.
- All holding tanks from campers must be drained from fluids
- Campers and pop-ups must remove all glass, LP tanks and any loose material inside.
- All fiberglass boats must have a relieve cut. Must have a cut halfway around the boat.
- NO ALUMINUM BOATS OR BOAT MOTORS ON BOATS
- Objective of race: Finish race with your trailer while separating the trailer of your competitors from their tow vehicles. If you loose your trailer during the race you will be DQ'd and you will be black flagged.

Roll Over Contest Rules

- 1) #1 rule is to have fun with this and driver's safety is a must!
- 2) Any Compact car
- 3) All burnable interior must be removed, removal of dash is optional. All insulation under hood must be removed.
- 4) Sunroof openings must be sealed off securely with steel
- 5) All glass must be removed from vehicle. All broken glass must be removed from the interior of the vehicle. Driver's window opening must be covered with window net.
- 6) Vehicles must be equipped with a roll cage. Roll cage must be a min of 4 points securely welded or mounted to the frame a chassis of the vehicle.
- 7) Vehicles must be equipped with min of 4 point racing restraint for the driver, the restraint must be attached the roll cage or frame of vehicle: Do not attach it to the seat! DRIVER'S SAFETY is #1
- 8) Drivers door must be welded or chained securely shut. Drivers opening must be equipped with racing net or covering.
- 9) Full face helmet is required, neck brace, long sleeve pants and shirts, and gloves are mandatory and fire suits are recommended.
- 10) Gas Tanks must remain in factory location with max of 2 gallons of gas.
- 11) Battery must be stock posted on and mounted securely

School Bus Race Rules

- 1) Any American made school bus with a wheelbase that is stock for year, make, and model. Motor must be in front of bus (no rear engine buses). No small buses (1 ton or less)
- 2) All glass must be removed except windshield.
- 3) If windshield is removed a heavy screen or mesh drives window must have screen or window net over it.
- 4) Gas tanks may be left in stock location. If removed a boat tank can be used and mounted inside, in the middle of bus and must be covered.
- 5) Bumper may be trimmed so they don't bend in to tires. Bumpers maybe reinforce front. Front can be reinforced to protect radiator. (See attach pictures for examples)
- 6) Helmets, long sleeve shirts, pants and shoes are required. Neck brace and fire suits are recommended.
- 7) All buses must have working seat belts. Racing harness is highly recommended.
- 8) All antifreeze must be removed.
- 9) Must have working brakes
