

Motorsport Olympics Destruction Rules

Labor Day of Doom Sunday Sept 4th, 2022
Pit Pass \$30 (No Entry Fee)
NO ANTIFREEZE IN ANY VEHICLES IN COMPETITION

- 1. Competition is open to 4 & 6 cylinder cars, small trucks & mini-vans can compete in the contest.
- 2. All glass except windshield must be removed. All lights, reflectors, and exterior trim must be removed. Any broken glass must be vacuumed out of car including inside the doors. All head lights (hide-away's also) must be removed. All outside mirrors must be removed. No Anti-freeze allowed.
- 3. Car must have a sound floor in drivers' area. Seat belts must be sound and operate.
- 4. All debris must be removed from car and trunk area.
- 5. Doors must be chained shut with sturdy chain or welded. No Duct Tape or Ratchet Straps.
- 6. All cars are recommended to have a back brace bar running from driver's side door post to passenger side door post. It must prevent the seat back from falling backward and support the driver's door in a collision. Bar must be at least 1 ½ inches in diameter (max size 3 inches) and have a minimum of 4 inch by 6 inch 1/4 inch thick plate welded to each end. Bar must be installed by welding or by four 3/8 inch bolts in each plate fastened securely to each side door post.
- 7. All cars must have a number pained on both sides (minimum of 16 inches high). Roof Signs ok with numbers.
- 8. No obscenity or inappropriate words allowed on car.
- 9. Gas tank should remain in stock location. If Changed Must be Recovered & Pass Inspection
- 10. All cars must past a safety inspection & deemed safe for competition.
- 11. Race Event contest rules will be given at Drivers Meeting.
- 12. You must be 18 to compete. Ages 16 to 17 can race with a notarized parental release form and parent in attendance.
- 13. All cars must leave the Speedway before the following Saturday or they become Speedway property and will be disposed of.
- 14. Drivers door should be left intact, Chained or Welded shut, Additional interior padding & Window Net recommended. No Duct Tape or Ratchet Straps.
- 15. Battery must be securely fastened at all times.
- 16. Fire Suit recommended or Drivers must wear long sleeved shirts (Heavy Flannel or Denim) and long pants (Blue Jeans). All drivers must wear eye protection (full face helmets, gloves, goggles, or glasses).

Events of Competition: (Minimum Payout is \$50 per entered car)

Feature Winner Chain Race \$100 to Each Winning Team member & Trophies

Feature Winner Grudge Race \$200 & Trophy

Feature Winner Auto Tag Team Race \$100 to Each Winning Team member & Trophies

Feature Winner Back-up Race \$200 to Win & Trophy

Feature Winner Skid Plate Place \$200 to Win & Trophy

Feature Winner Pick-up Truck Events \$200 Chain Race \$100 Burnout Contest & Trophy

(Sept 4th 2022 Trailer Race) 2WD Tow Vehicles: \$500 To Win plus Trophy & \$200 to each participant who brings their own tow vehicle & trailer if registered by Aug 28th, 2022 \$100 to start & \$250 to win if registered after Aug 28th, 2022 (no entry fee) (don't be late) \$100 to win Best Decorated/Theme Trailer (Fan Vote) before race.

Trailer Race Rules Labor Day of Doom Show Sept 4th, 2022 NO FIBERGLASS BOATS!!

1. VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY SPECIFICATIONS: Dells Raceway Park Officials reserves the right to determine whether a vehicle meets the applicable specifications for the Event. Only vehicles determined to meet the applicable specifications are eligible to compete in the Event. Any full size tow vehicles cars, vans, pick-up trucks ¾ ton or less, suburban, station wagon or suv's etc...(4x4's Must have one drive shaft removed) NO CONVERTIBLES. Tow vehicles must be stripped of all glass except front windshield. Tow Vehicles must be stripped of all flammable materials (rugs, headliners, door panels etc.). All exterior lights and body moldings must be removed. Batteries must remain in stock location and be securely fastened and covered. All parts must be factory stock for that year, make and model. NO lift kits or suspension alterations allowed. NO reinforcing allowed except to front of car for radiator protection. Driver door must be welded or wired shut (#9 Wire or larger). Roll Cage or Roll Protection is Highly Recommended. Tow Vehicle must display a one or two digit number the full height of the door on each side of the vehicle for identification purposes. NO foam filled tires allowed. NO AIR BAGS...If vehicle has an air bag it must be disconnected and ripped out. No antifreeze in radiators.

2. TRAILER ELIGIBILITY SPECIFICATIONS: NO HOME MADE TRAILERS ALLOWED.

Overall Trailer Length: Minimum length 10 feet measured from hitch ball socket. Suggestions are travel trailers, pop-up tent campers and boat trailers. Pop-up trailers must be raced in the fully extended (popped-up) position. Trailers cannot be rigged to self-destruct, leaving only frame to continue racing and must be able to race without falling apart. Trailers should be destroyed only upon impact with another vehicle. If a trailer is rigged to self-destruct, thereby gaining a racing advantage, that driver will be disqualified. All appliances and heating/cooling units must be removed. Glass must be removed. Trailers must be completely cleaned out on inside, removing everything that is not part of the unit; i.e. pots and pans, clothes, silverware, trash, household items or anything that is not a permanent part of trailer as manufactured. Tongue must attach to tow vehicle by hitch ball, free pivoting. Safety chains and equalizer bars are not allowed. No pintle hitches. No clasp type hitches. Ballast weight may not be added. ABSOLUTELY NO SAFETY CHAINS ALLOWED, No Welds on Hitch to Ball, No Duct Tape.

3. DRIVER ELIGIBILTY: Drivers must be at least 18 years of age.

All drivers MUST attend the MANDATORY pre-event drivers meeting. NO PASSENGERS ALLOWED Sobriety is Mandatory by all drivers prior to and during the race.

- 4. DRIVER PROTECTION: A DOT/Snell approved crash HELMET IS REQUIRED with working chin strap. Drivers MUST wear long pants, shoes or boots, Long sleeve shirt and gloves while on the track. Approved fire suit & neck collar recommended. Shoulder and lap belt required. Each competitor is solely responsible for the effectiveness of personal safety equipment used during an event. Dells Raceway Park is not responsible for the effectiveness of any personal safety equipment.
- 5. EVENT RULES: Any time a tow vehicle becomes separated from trailer that vehicle will be deemed unable to Compete for the remainder of event. Trailer (frame) must remain intact from hitch through and including axle or it will be deemed unable to compete for the remainder of event.

Do not leave cockpit of tow vehicle until event ends, unless on fire or instructed to do so by Track official. Keep seat belts and helmets on at all times. Object of competition is to dislodge trailer from the other competitors. No Vehicle-to-vehicle hits, must hit the trailer. ANY CONTACT WITHTHE TOW/PULL VEHICLE DURING THE RACE MAY CAUSE DISQUALIFIATION. Participants merely racing around the track trying to avoid contact of making contact will be disqualified....Remember the fans are looking for a show of destruction. Event winner will be the last vehicle running with tow trailer (and axle) attached, maximum time limit may be enforced after 10 minutes to determine winner by track official and/or fan vote.
